## March 24th Minutes

President John Rannenberg called the meeting to order at 7:20. He spoke about the show and thanked all the volunteers- Linda, Laureen, Bridget, Sabrina, Debbie, among others. The judges were very pleased with the quality of the horses, and the Hesses, who photographed the show, enjoyed the show. The final count was 103 horses. 25 horses were scratched, which hurt us a bit. We also had our first memorial trophy for Julane White, and Sarah won it for the Show Hack Amateur. We know that Julane would have liked that. John also purchased five smaller trophies to be given out each year at the Amateur show. There should be a picture of it for the website. Thanks for Barb Copping for taking over the website.

The Adult Junior and Senior Service Award is due April 10<sup>th</sup>. Robin Ford reported High Point. The only people to nominate were Robin and Sabrina Jarema. Small plaques were given out and next year it will be better publicized. Arabian News may be out of business. Our articles could be sent to Horse and Pony instead and they could be put on the website as well.

Elections- John called for nominations from the floor. The nominees are: John Rannenberg for President, Laureen Ford for Treasurer, Sabrina Jarema for Secretary, Debbie Paisley for Vice President, and Linda Roberts and Joe Kinley for the Board, with Robin Ford and Barbara Copping continuing. John called for a vote for the slate as stated and all were in favor.

John spoke about the excellent Dressage clinic that was held the day after the show. We thank Greta Wrigley for hosting the clinic. He asked about what else we would like to do as a club. He explained the Horse Lovers' Tour that had been held in the past. He needs feedback. He's not certain that we can do another horse show, with the economy being what it is. We may need other options, like schooling shows and open shows, though there are other open shows in the area.

Laureen wondered if she should reserve the dates at the Pavilion for next year. Ocala Equestrian Center (OEC) was discussed. John said he'd like to go there and hear what they have to say before we sign with the Pavilion. The footing at the Pavilion is bad, especially for Dressage. Dressage and Sport Horse is a big money maker, so we should keep that in mind. OEC has a covered warm up area. Barb said she went through it for the Sport Horse show we had planned and it was nice, but there might be a problem with parking and big rigs. She didn't like the stalls, but John said he didn't feel they were too bad. We have some time before we need to sign with the Pavilion. Linda Roberts suggested we might have a meeting there so we can see the facilities. Laureen said we have the time. If we can do this, the meeting will be on April 28 at 6:30. There was general discussion about the Pavilion and problems that were encountered.

Debbie asked whether we should have meetings every other month. John said we have more people when we have it at members' farms and we discussed the possibilities. Robin said that something we haven't done in a while is a trail ride and people discussed it. John will talk to Lois about it. She also said we enjoyed the clinic we held at the University. We talked about touring the Vet School. If anyone has any other ideas for club activities, please let us know. Linda said we should have a clinic for Sport Horse Under Saddle and In Hand. Sport Horse was discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:25.

## April 27th Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM by President John Rannenberg at the Ocala

Equestrian Complex (OEC).

No Treasurer or Secretary's Reports were given.

We took a tour of the complex. John called for vote on OEC and everyone seemed to like the facilities. There are fewer stalls, but the facility is better. We need to draw in other larger farms to the show. We've lost some Dressage and Sport Horse entries because of footing. We will need to check with OBS to see if there's a conflict for stalls as there aren't enough stalls here. The facility seems to be well run. If we make this change we need to keep in mind that we'll be expanding. There would be a covered arena for Dressage. It's more expensive but there's more bang for the buck. Vendor space is better. If we're going to do this, we need to get behind the club with sponsorships. Greta Wrigley mentioned that we can expand the Sport Horse division, such as offering Championship classes. We can look at the track records of the numbers of the horses in the various classes overall and make some changes. We need to commit to change or we can just go along, which is all right, but we need to decide.

John said there may be conflict with the Canterbury Show. But this show is geared toward the amateur and we need to see if we want to restructure with more classes for the Open horses. Cost is more at OEC but there's much more facility.

## April 27th Minutes—Continued -

We need to have a Show Committee meeting to decide, but John said he wanted to put it to the club in general. The consensus is that we should go on with this. The show may die a slow death if we stay at the Pavilion. We need to advertise and spread the word. We need to find out about OBS's stalls and what the cost would be.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:19 p.m. The next meeting will be on May 26 at Seminole.
