MAY 25, 2009 MINUTES

President John Rannenberg called the meeting to order at 7:22 p.m. He wanted know if anyone had a chance to look at the OAHA website. He thanked Barb Copping, who has become our Web Master for doing it. We also thanked her for taking pictures at Region 12 of the Dressage Champions, Reserves and Top Fives. John asked about Nancy Bjordahl, the Hoofbeats News Editor. She is thinking of coming to Florida and would like to visit us.

Laureen said the newsletter is too expensive. It cost \$300 per printing. If we put it only on our Web site, some people wouldn't be able to get it. We need to coordinate the mailing list and the list of people who want to get it by mail. It's put together outside of the club and we need to keep it in house. John wondered if we can do a survey, in a postcard, to find out who wants it in e-mail and who wants a hard copy. Laureen and Barb discussed revising and updating the e-mail lists. We all agreed that the club will send out a postcard to verify member's e-mail addresses. If someone needs it by regular mail, they will need to let us know. Bridget will do the printing if there are fifty or fewer copies being sent out. Barb will take care of the postcard.

Treasurer's Report: Given by Laureen Ford. She also gave the financial report from the Amateur Show. There was a slight loss for the show in general, but it wasn't as bad as first thought. The Pavilion raised its price on the ring and the stalls. We didn't pay out all the class money we had. We lost vendors and we had no sponsorships. We used to make a profit on the bedding, but the Pavilion raised the prices quite a bit and that hurt us as well

Bridget did a comparison on the prices of the Pavilion vs. the Ocala Equestrian Center (OEC). At first look, it appeared that we would lose money; however there were variables she could not figure on. It would take about 35 more horses with two classes each to help make up for the difference. John said it will be a show committee decision. There will be an opportunity to get more people to the show. A little money here and there, with sponsorships for example, will help. Laureen asked if we really want to risk more expenses when the economy is so bad. We'll lose more entries, but it's the same all over, at any show. John said he's in favor

moving, but he can look at it from both sides. If we make a change, we need to get behind it as a group. There are still people showing, but we may be sticking our necks out by the increased expenses. It'll be more of a commitment as a club, as far as advertising and getting our name out.

One thing that sets our show apart is that it is an amateur show. We need to offer other things, like more To Be Announced (TBA) classes for the professionals. We need a different hook. We also need to get the Dressage and Sport Horse people back, and add Pro/Am classes. We need to talk to the trainers and see what they would like. We need to review the schedule and see what we need to put into the TBA division.

Debbie Paisley said we should put it to the club members in general. There was discussion as to whether we should decide tonight or wait. A general vote was held by a show of hands and the vote was for OEC. John said the footing is bad at the Pavilion and that is the main reason we should move. If they would take care of that, we could stay, but as it is, we'll lose too many entries. John said he'll talk to OEC to see if they can work with us on the prices.

Linda suggested we get pictures of OEC and put it on our website to show the new facilities. John said that before the next show, we can do a letter in the prize list and let everyone know about the move.

Lauren spoke about the OAHA Scholarship. There were seven applicants. Lisa Fultz wrote a good letter about her interests and history with Arabians in her family and she is the recipient. Lauren also spoke about the OAHA Service Award. Barbara was the only adult who applied. There are three juniors who applied.

There will be no OAHA meetings in either June or July. The meeting adjourned at 8:24.

John had the first Arabian farm in Marion County, Fl, 41 years ago and was a past president of the Arabian Assoc in New Jersey before that. Some of his Top Ten and National Champions, along with their famous get, were Hanraff by Raffles, Mon Ta Basko, Baskin Robbins, Monty Python, Moncedes Benz, Basquel, Galadril Spirit, Flicker, Triscuit, Mon Celicia, China Doll, Monseratti, Basko Fantique, Rushah, Mon Band Aid, I'm A Ten, Mon Ta Chianna, Rocky Rhoda, Mon Fla Bask, and more. Most of these were Halter, then went on to Park or English Pleasure. There was a Remembrance for him July 19 at Luigis restaurant. John Monsees really had a good life and is survived by his wife, Delcie.
